Meals on Wheels

2019 has been a year of challenges and change for Coon Rapids-Blaine Meals on Wheels. Our first challenge was the unexpected death of our administrator, Bridget Platt, early in the year. Our second challenge came in September when Camilia Rose terminated the agreement to provide us with office space and preparation of meals. Our first meeting with the other Anoka County Meals on Wheels programs and Metro Meals on Wheels was in early October. Our goal at that meeting was that no client would miss a meal. It was soon determined that the best solution was for Coon Rapids-Blaine Meals on Wheels to merge with Impact Services. There are now 2 Meals on Wheels programs in Anoka County. Southern Anoka County Meals on Wheels provides meals for Spring Lake Park, Fridley, Columbia Heights and Hilltop. Impact Services provides meals for the rest of Anoka County, including Coon Rapids and Blaine.

Our church provided the drivers for December 2 through 6 which was the first week with Impact Services. I am grateful to say that we achieved our goal that no client would miss a meal. Meals are now picked up at Mercy Healthcare Center. Impact Services provided just under 1,100 meals that week.

Thank you to CRUMC members who helped make our first week a success. This generous gift of time allows many elderly, disabled, and homebound people in Coon Rapids and Blaine to remain in their homes. Our next week to provide drivers is February 3 through February 7. We can always use more drivers. Delivering meals takes about 1½ hours over the lunch hour.
